Commercial Insurance:

Step 1: Investigate autism benefits through insurance

- 3 options:
 - a. Visit website of **Autism Alliance of Michigan**, click the "Contact MiNavigator" tab and complete the form. A navigator will be assigned to you and can perform an insurance investigation on your behalf. They will then give information about approved autism evaluation centers
 - b. Call a local company who can perform an insurance investigation on your behalf and then give you evaluation center options based on their findings
 - i. Centria Healthcare (855) 772-8847Trumpet Behavioral Health (855) 824-5669Lumen Pediatric Therapy (888) 485-8636
 - c. Contact insurance company yourself and ask to speak to the autism benefit department
 - i. Ask: "where do I go for a diagnosis for my child" and "what services are covered" (Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, ABA therapy?)
- **Step 2**: Make an appointment for **autism testing** based on insurance requirements

***<u>For BCBS</u>: BCBS requires Autism to be diagnosed through an AAEC (Autism Approved Evaluation Center). These centers usually have very long waitlists. An initial ADOS (Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule) evaluation can take place **WHILE** you are on the waitlist for an evaluation at an AECC. If Autism is diagnosed with an ADOS test, the evaluator can apply for a "bridge authorization" to begin therapies right away, while you await your required full evaluation at an AAEC.

Medicaid Insurance:

Step 1A: Request an access manager through your county

- Macomb County: Macomb County Access Center (586) 948-0222
- Wayne County: Wayne Mental Health Authority (800) 241-4949
- Oakland County: Oakland County Health Network (248) 464-6363
 - a. First state that you are "in need of an autism evaluation" which will refer you to an access manager
 - b. A phone screening will occur to determine the need for a further in-depth autism evaluation
 - c. Access manager will assign you to an evaluation center (if you need an in-home evaluation, request at this time)

Step 1B: While you are working with your county's access center, you can start calling to get on the waitlist for an autism evaluation at the same time. This may help speed up the process of getting an evaluation for your child.

Step 2: If autism is diagnosed, findings will be sent to the state. The state of Michigan will need to approve the diagnosis (this may take several weeks)

Step 3: Once the state approves, you will be referred to an ABA therapy provider who takes Medicaid insurance (some will provide in-home ABA if needed)
